

URBP6001 Research Seminar

This course is a formalized version of the existing Departmental Seminar Series (also known as 'Postgraduate Seminars'). The Department's teaching staff and postgraduate students, as well as invited guest speakers outside of the Department, will make presentations of their research findings which are held throughout the academic year. Students are expected to be active participants in the seminars.

The performance of the student's own presentation, along with the student's participation in the discussion at the research colloquium will be used as the basis for determining the grade of the students. There will be no other course requirement and no final written examination. The students are expected to obtain a passing grade, under a pass/fail grading system, in this course before they are allowed to proceed further in their studies.

Assessment:

- Attendance to research seminars organized by the DUPAD/CUSUP
- Presentation in the research seminar and submission of research proposal for review

Schedule:

No regular schedule. Students will be informed of details of research seminars by email.
